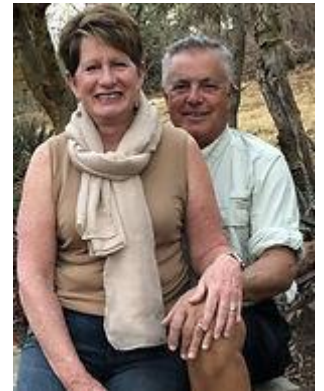

DOE: National Transmission Planning Study

On October 16, the Department of Energy's (DOE) Grid Deployment Office held a webinar on the National Transmission Planning Study, showing national, long-term planning analysis on transmission expansion options for the next 15-to-30 years. The study and webinar discussed creating and expanding transmission planning tools, such as open-source software, new modeling techniques, and free research licenses that DOE is helping to make more available to planning entities such as utilities and state governments.
